GP JOULE PROJECTS Ireland sells Blackhall Solar Farm to Elgin

Blackhall Solar Farm has a planned capacity of 210 MWp and is ready to build

**GP JOULE PROJECTS has successfully completed the sale of the Blackhall Solar Farm in County Meath, Ireland, to Irish investor Elgin. With a planned capacity of around 210 MWp, Blackhall is one of the country's major utility-scale photovoltaic developments and the second large-scale PV project driven forward by GP JOULE PROJECTS Ireland.**

The Irish team of GP JOULE PROJECTS has led the development of Blackhall Solar Farm from its early stages through planning and permitting to the sale. The closing of the transaction marks an important milestone for GP JOULE's international project development activities and for the further decarbonisation of the Irish power sector.

Ciaran Donnelly, Head of Ireland at GP JOULE PROJECTS, explains: "We are pleased to have completed the sale of Blackhall Solar Farm to Elgin. From the outset, we have worked closely with the local community, and we are proud of the work that has gone into bringing Blackhall to this stage. We look forward to seeing Elgin take the project forward into its next phase and ultimately into operation."

Boris Beltermann, Managing Director of GP JOULE PROJECTS, adds: "The sale of Blackhall Solar Farm to Elgin is a milestone for GP JOULE PROJECTS and our Irish subsidiary, GP JOULE PROJECTS Ireland. The project will make a significant contribution to meeting the growing demand for electricity from wind and solar power in Ireland and to strengthening the long-term supply of renewable energy."

"We are pleased that we have a number of additional wind and solar projects in the Irish pipeline which we will be bringing to market in the coming months and years. Ireland is an exceptionally attractive market for investors looking to build future-proof energy infrastructure, thanks to its high electricity demand and very favourable regulatory and market conditions."

Dermot Kelleher, CEO Elgin: "Blackhall is one of the largest late-stage solar development opportunities in the Irish market and represents a significant addition to Elgin's Irish platform. As we continue to grow our portfolio of owned renewable energy assets, projects like Blackhall will play an important role in supporting Ireland's decarbonisation ambitions, energy security and long-term economic growth."

The sale underscores the role of GP JOULE PROJECTS as an international developer of wind and solar parks, with activities in Germany, Italy, France and Ireland. Both parties have agreed not to disclose the purchase price.
